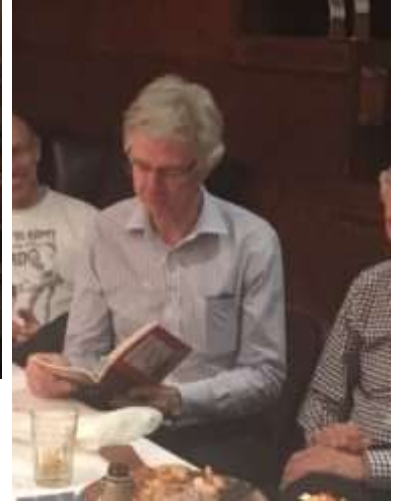
WHO WILL BE KING?
