The President's Patter ...

Last week we had the rare opportunity to have as our guest two Olympic road cyclists who represented Australia – Liz Hepple, the road ride in Seoul, 1988 and Katrin Garfoot, time trial at Rio this year.

Katrin's story is a good lesson to us all. Katrin told us of how she started recreational mountain bike cycling in October 2012 – how remarkable is it that in 2014 Katrin is standing on the podium in Glasgow at the Commonwealth Games receiving the Bronze medal for the time trial. Someone observed her cycling skills and helped her search out what to do with those skills.

Katrin's rapid progression from newcomer in the sport in 2012 to representing her country in 2014 is testament to her natural skills on a bicycle. Katrin's story prompts two questions

- how many people may have a particular skill and they do not know; and
- how do we search out those skills?

We ask these questions in the broader sense of skills, not just sporting; it might be playing bridge, writing poetry or running a marathon. At changeover Everald Compton issued the challenge at age 84 it is not too late to write a book.

So how we do we each search out those skills and how do we recognise special skills in our friends and family around us so we can encourage them to seek out their opportunities. A challenging question.


Rotary Club of Brisbane High-Rise ANZAC Day 2017 Project

Resting peacefully on the eastern beach of Fraser Island is the TSS Maheno – during WW1 the Maheno was a hospital ship, arriving at Anzac beach on the morning of 26 August 1915; there the crew retrieved the wounded Australian and New Zealand soldiers.

A winter cyclone in 1935 caused the towline to break resulting in the Maheno being beached on Fraser Island, sparing her from the shipbreakers' torches in Japan.
