

# Rotary Club of Brisbane High-Rise ANZAC Day 2017 Project

Resting peacefully on the eastern beach of Fraser Island is the TSS Maheno – during WW1 the Maheno was a hospital ship, arriving at Anzac beach on the morning of 26 August 1915; there the crew retrieved the wounded Australian and New Zealand soldiers.


A winter cyclone in 1935 caused the towline to break resulting in the Maheno being beached on Fraser Island, sparing her from the shipbreakers' torches in Japan.
