I seem to remember to put effort into that – just wish I could do the same when it comes to packing scarves and gloves.

Last week we all had the opportunity to meet Georgia and Inez (thank you John G). Young people learning the value of giving to the community. I glanced through Georgia's workbook and it's a great Rotary program...think we might investigate given the number of primary school age children we have or can make contact with.   - Must be sustainable
- Packaged Grants Fully Funded by World Fund
  - Strategic Partnerships developed by TRF
