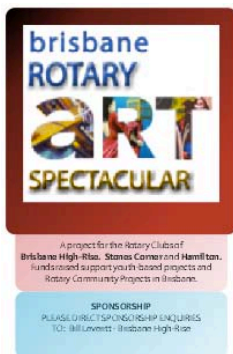

Rotarians Against Malaria (RAM) project in Solomon Islands

Good morning All, I require by **Monday the 8th of October expressions of interest** for the following project at Seghe, Solomon Islands. Seghe is at the bottom end of New Georgia Island in the Western Province. There is two houses to be built at Seghe to house "Rotarians Against Malaria" staff. The first group of 8 will leave on the 31st of October and return to Australia on the 14th of November. The second group of 8 will leave on the 13th of November and return to Australia on the 27th of November. The following is information in no particular order; - All tools are on site - I require one Builder, one Plumber and 5 or 6 workers in the first group. - I require one Builder, one Plumber, one Electrician and 4 or 5 workers in the second group. - All internal airfares and accommodation and meals are paid for. - You will be required to fund your trip from Australia to Honiara and back. - You will need to pay for your overnight stay in Honiara on Tuesday night the 13th of November - The total cost to you will be about \$1600.00 plus alcohol and carvings and the Rotary Meeting in Honiara. - Both teams will cross over in Honiara and meet with the Honiara Rotary Club on the Tuesday night. - I require two team leaders for each group. It is fine for Females to travel and work as well. - You will need a passport and you will need to complete the RAWCS application forms to register. (Rotary Australia World Community Service). I will email the application forms to you when required.

At the age of ten, Julia underwent a surgical procedure that left her without the permanent use of her legs. Julia currently relies on an ordinary wheelchair which severely limits her independence.

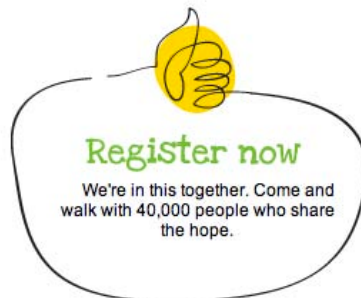
