**UPDATE - Mamba School Project** - After much work by a number of members, in particular Jennifer Eathorne, we have submitted our proposal to the Rotary Foundation seeking matching grants for the proposed upgrade of facilities at this little school in Tanzania. The first hurdle was the approval and support of our District; we got that about mid last year so it is a long process just to get this far. Final approval is not automatic; we can expect close scrutiny of our proposal and intense questioning. We also need the support of the local Tanzanian Club and District. That is not easy either and we have had some communications difficulties over the last few months. However we seem to have made a bit of a breakthrough in recent weeks to the extent that we can be confident now that we will get formal acknowledgement of support as and when required. Over the Xmas period my son – in – law, Africa Silayo, and his family were in Tanzania. Africa visited the school and met with the Principal and school committee along with a representative of the local Rotary Club Mkuu Rombo. This was an important link up. We have now initiated specification and quotes for the first project which is to refurbish two of the original classrooms. They are inoperable at this point. We have the funds to do this work irrespective of the results of the submission to the Rotary Foundation. One bit of good news to announce is that the Rotary Club of Gympie – Cooloola have donated \$1,000 towards the project. Our link to this Club is through past members Paul and Barbara Barnaby. Clearly they retain an interest in the happenings within High – Rise.

By the way, depending to some extent on building progress, there is an intention for another visit to the Mamba school in mid-January 2014. Keep that in mind if there is an interest in an African adventure. **Bill Phillips**

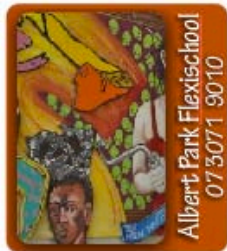

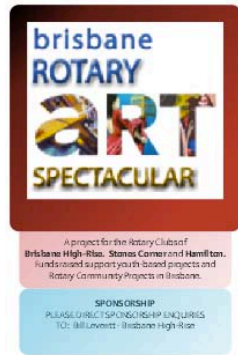
