AYAN and EDNA Visa Update - In case you have not had time to read the recent Update via email (31st Aug.), here briefly, is a snapshot of where we are currently at. Our team's ongoing goal is to overturn the original Visa rejection by the Australian High Commission in Nairobi. Attached to my previous Update was Minter Ellison's complete second Visa submission to be assessed again, by the Australian High Commission. Megan and her team went to extraordinary lengths researching and presenting valid arguments and evidence in support of both Ayan and Edna's 'genuine' status. The Visa submissions left Minter Ellison's office on 28th August en route to Nairobi. We are awaiting confirmation that they have arrived in Kenya. As soon as a file number is assigned to the submission, I will circulate it to all members. This will allow those who wish to forward emails in support of Ayan and Edna, to do so. I do hope many of you will help out when the time arrives! Please email me if you would like a copy of Minter Ellison's second submission (nphil4@gmail.com). I believe this document will motivate you to help Ayan and Edna in whatever way you choose. The compelling facts will support any representations you may make to Elected Representatives, Media contacts or friends. I ask again, that you contact me IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A COPY OF THE SUBMISSION. Please speak to or email any one of the Project Team - John Arvier, Susan Rix, Lindsay Marshall, Ken Parker (Mitchelton Rotary Club) should you require further information. As this is a Club Project, any offers of advice or assistance would be greatly appreciated. There will not be another submission. This is it. Together with the Minter Ellison team, our determination to see a fair outcome for Ayan and Edna has not waivered. Noela Phillips
