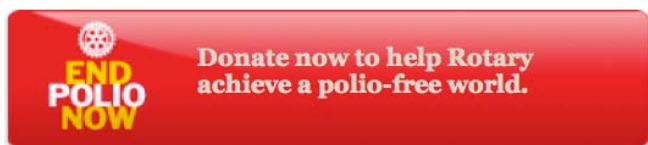
BRIC HOUSING – GARAGE SALE – SATURDAY 17 APRIL
