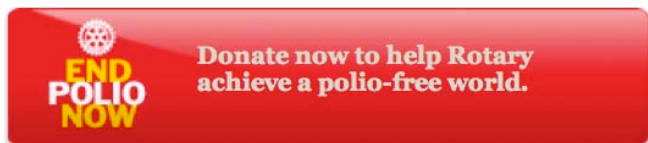

### UPDATE - BRETT MITCHELL HONOURED ON RIO WEBSITE

Brett McKay Mitchell and his life partner, Yao-dong Tuan, who both died in a car accident in 2007, were posthumously honored during ceremonies at RI World Headquarters in Evanston, Illinois, USA, where their portraits now hang in the Arch C. Klumph Gallery.

Brett Mitchell joined Rotary in 1993 and was a member of the Rotary Club of Brisbane High-Rise, Queensland, Australia. He served as club secretary and board member.

Brett worked as a corporate regulator for the Australian Securities and Investments Commission and was also a chartered accountant, certified information systems auditor, and certified practicing risk manager. He was a member of the finance committee for the Legacy Club of Brisbane and of the management committee for the Queensland Community Foundation.

Mitchell and his life partner, Tuan, supported the Permanent Fund and the Annual Programs Fund.
