Laura Catharina Crous-Beckett 14 May 2008 – 25 January 2010

It is with much sadness we learnt of the death of Colin Beckett's daughter Laura. Most of us will be aware that Laura has been fighting a tenacious battle for life since her near drowning some seven weeks ago. The day after her passing Colin sent the following email:

As some of you have learned – and others will now realise – our darling Laura lost her battle with life yesterday at around 04:10 in the afternoon. The end was sudden – and unexpected. Only a couple of hours previously Dr Bartlett had told us that he was happy with her progress and expected she would be back on the conventional ventilator within a day or so. But then all of a sudden her saturation levels dropped – and this time also her heart rate and blood pressure and within a few moments she was gone. Both Hestie and I, as well as Hestie's sister Corne, were with Laura at the end. We can console ourselves that we gave her as much love and encouragement as we possibly could – and she in turn put every possible effort into staying with us – but in the end The Lord saw fit to take her. We must believe that in His wisdom, He could not guarantee Laura's quality of life in this world – so He decided to take her to His!

Our sympathy and our condolences go out to Colin and Hestie. Moving to other issues Bill Phillips has managed to secure Gemma Sisia founder of the School of St Jude in Tanzania to speak to our club on the 11th February. We are inviting other Clubs to join us and it's fair to say that Gemma will be one of our Keynote Speakers for the year. If you have not heard Gemma speak before make sure you do not miss her address.
